NOTICE INVITING SEALED PROPOSALS OR BIDS FOR

2010 CalEMA 400 ESPLANADE STORM DRAIN OUTFALL

The City of Pacifica invites sealed proposals or bids for Esplanade storm drain outfall relocation and repair as described in the contract documents entitled

2010 CalEMA 400 ESPLANADE STORM DRAIN OUTFALL

on file in the Office of the City Engineer at 151 Milagra Drive (650 738-3767) in said City and to which reference is hereby expressly made for more particular description of the work to be done. All work is to be done in accordance with said plans and specifications.

General work description:

The 2010 CalEMA 400 Esplanade Storm Drain Outfall project will abandon the storm drain located on 380 Esplanade and will re-route all drainage that flows through the 380 Esplanade outfall to a new storm drain system running south within the Esplanade street right of way to 400 Esplanade. The proposed system will install approximate 900 linear feet of new pipe, 4 new manholes, 1 new drainage inlet and a new storm drain outfall on 400 of Esplanade just south of West Manor Drive.

Bids due by: November 17, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.

A Class A (General Engineering) or appropriate specialty contractor's license is required for this contract.

Payments will be made by said City to the Contractor in accordance with provisions of the specifications and on itemized estimates duly certified and approved by the City Engineer submitted in accordance herewith, based upon labor and materials incorporated into said work.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City of Pacifica has heretofore established a prevailing rate and scale of wages. Reference is hereby made to said list of prevailing wage rates which has been determined pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, and which are heretofore established by reference. The prevailing rate and scale of wages for this contract is the determination made by the Director of Industrial Relations as applicable to San Mateo County. A copy of the Determination is on file at the office of the City Engineer.

The Contractor shall, in the performance of the work and improvements conform to the Labor Code of the State of California and other laws of the State of California applicable hereto.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check payable to the order of said City amounting to 10% of the bid or by a bond in said amount and payable to said City, signed by the bidder and a corporate surety or by the bidder and two sureties who shall testify before any officer competent to administer an oath. Said check shall be forfeited or said bond shall become payable to said City in case the bidder depositing the same does not, within 10 days after written notice that the contract has been awarded to said bidder, enter into a contract with the City.

Successful Contractor shall furnish City a faithful performance bond and labor and material bond and insurance certificates as required in these specifications.

The City of Pacifica hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, sex, age, color, national origin, creed, sexual orientation or marital status in consideration for an award.

Minimum wage rates for this project as predetermined by the Secretary of Labor are set forth in the special provisions. If there is a difference between the minimum wage rates predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and prevailing wage rates determined by the Department of Industrial Relations for similar classifications of labor, the Contractor and his subcontractors shall pay not less than the higher wage rate.

The time fixed for receiving sealed bids or proposals for the doing of said work and improvements herein ordered is **November 17, 2010**, at the hour of **10:00 a.m.** o'clock at the Office of the City Clerk, 170 Santa Maria Avenue, Pacifica, California 94044, which said time and place are hereby fixed as the time and place of a public meeting, at which said public meeting said bids will be publicly opened, examined and declared by the City Clerk; said bids, after being publicly opened, examined and declared, will be calculated by the Engineer of Work, their report returned to the City Clerk, and the report of the results of the bidding and the calculations of the Engineer of Work will be reported to the City Council of the City of Pacifica at the next regular meeting thereof. The City Council of the City of Pacifica reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or bids, should it deem this necessary for the public good, and

also the bid of any bidder who has been delinquent or unfaithful in any former contract with the City of Pacifica.

The contractor shall begin work within 15 calendar days after receiving a notice that the contract has been approved by the City.

Time of completion for all work shall be **30** working days after notice to proceed.

The Engineer's estimate is **\$485,000.00**.
